

BYLAW NO. 2/58.

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENFORCEMENT OF
THE BYLAWS OF THE MUNICIPALITY.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Marquis No. 191
of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known and referred to as "The General Penalty Bylaw" of the Municipality.
2. Section 3 shall apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided and which such bylaw states shall incur the penalties herein provided.
3. Subject to the provisions of Section 3, any person found guilty of an infraction of any bylaw of the municipality passed by authority of the Rural Municipality Act shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding One Hundred Dollars and costs for every offence, and in default of payment, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty days unless the said penalty and costs including costs of committal, are sooner paid.
4. All penalties and fines imposed for infraction of a bylaw shall, unless otherwise provided for, be paid to the Treasurer for the public use of the municipality.
5. General Penalty Bylaw No. 4, Passed August 15th, 1912 is hereby repealed.
